_____ **Membership/Recruitment Committee** - This committee serves as a resource for member retention and recruitment, as well as membership information. It is charged with reviewing membership applications, making recommendation to the Board and various "housekeeping" functions, including periodic surveys, coordination of the renewal process with the chapter Administrator, membership changes such as moves, name changes, address changes, etc. The committee holds membership retention and recruitment activities, including events such the wine-tasting in 2009.

_____ **Sponsorship Committee** - This committee is charged with overseeing all sponsorship coordination and "asks" for CREW Austin. This high-energy exciting committee works with the Board to deliver sponsors and create effective strategies to build the teams that do fundraising.

_____ **Programs Committee** - This committee serves as a resource to identify speakers and innovative/leading-edge topics, develop and structure interesting formats for presentations, identify professional skills development training, and recommend delivery vehicles for these programming opportunities. The programs are the primary source of exposure and credibility for the organization, and provide a substantial portion of CREW Austin's annual revenue. In order to increase overall attendance and meet the needs of the membership, A variety of programs should be established each year.

_____ **Public Relations Committee** - This committee is responsible for providing editorial guidance and content for the chapter's monthly newsletter. Committee members assist with the development of the editorial calendar, set standards for written articles, review article submissions and make recommendations on how to continue to promote and obtain exposure for CREW Austin and its members. Members also work with each "event" committee (i.e., UCREW, CREW Careers, WRTC, etc.) to insure appropriate promotion and exposure for those involved and the organization.

_____ **UCREW Committee** - This committee is charged with overseeing, developing and implementing the UCREW program, currently with the University of Texas McCombs School of Business. In addition to developing a "for credit" curriculum for university student participants, the committee will oversee a scholarship program (\$2,500 has been budgeted for 2010).

_____ **CREW Careers Committee** - This committee is charged with overseeing, developing and implementing the CREW Careers program, currently in partnership with the Ann Richards School for Young Women Leaders. In 2010, the day-long program will involve the entire 9th grade class and many, many volunteers, with the goal of introducing young students to the many educational and career opportunities offered in the field of real estate.

_____ **Women Run The City™ Committee** - 2010 marks the inaugural year for CREW Austin's chip-timed 5 Mile/Family 1 Mile race. Proceeds of the race will help fund the CREW Careers program and UCREW university internship and scholarship programs, and support CREW National's university scholarship endowment, all of which programs are aimed at providing women and girls with the tools needed for economic self-sufficiency.

_____ **Special Events* & Golf Committee** - This committee is responsible for CREW Austin's annual Golf Adventure, the holiday party and various other events, including monthly dine arounds. The committee should be comprised of highly energetic, passionate and organized individuals.

_____ **Recognition Committee** - This committee is responsible for developing programs that uncover examples of excellence in our membership that exemplify the core values of CREW Austin and showcase the value of membership.

_____ **Strategic Planning Task Force** - Our task forces are short term, usually six months in duration, and give you an opportunity to work with other members interested in a common project that requires an in-depth analysis. This task force will review our existing strategic plan and modify and enhance the strategic plan for the next five years. Your efforts will culminate in a new revised plan that will take CREW Austin and its membership into the future, addressing future needs as well as ensuring that we are on the right track as it relates to our core fundamentals as an organization.
